All or any portion of the borrowing authorized by this order may be obtained through the Massachusetts Clean Water Trust (the "Trust"), and in that regard, the Mayor and any other appropriate officials of the City are authorized to execute and deliver any and all agreements or certificates that the Trust may require in connection with any such borrowing.

Further Ordered, that any premium received by the City upon the sale of any bonds or notes approved by this order, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, may be applied to the payment of costs of the projects authorized by this order in accordance with G.L. c. 44, §20, thereby reducing the amount authorized to be borrowed to pay such costs by a like amount.
