Please see attached for the delineation sketch of Wareham Street that can be forwarded to the surveyors. We assessed the entire limits of work, but the only resource areas that exist are in the vicinity of the Nemasket River crossing. We included a note for the surveyors to locate the concrete walls associated with the herring run, as those will delineate the Banks of that stream.

We have also identified some stormwater concerns – it looks there is a (former) DPW building directly east of the Nemasket River, and excess runoff from the roadway sheet flows across the parking lots and has created scour down to the river. We will provide pictures with our delineation report.
