grant to George Edward Mansfield and Margaret Anne Mansfield, husband and wife as joint tenants with rights of survivorship

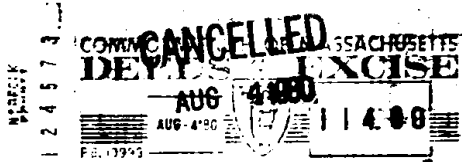
of Newton, Middlesex County, Massachusetts with quitclaim covenants

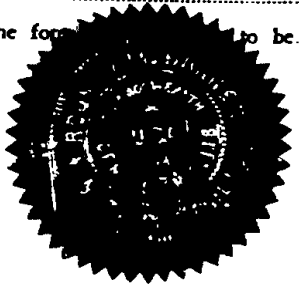
